The next scheduled Exemplification of the Fourth Degree will be in Tucson on Saturday, April 12th, 2008. This ceremonial and the banquet will be at The **Holiday Inn Palo Verde**, 4550 South Palo Verde Blvd., Tucson, AZ 85714-1995 (website <http://www.holidayinntucsonairport.com>) [Email: holidayinntucson@jgh.com] phone 520-746-1161, FAX 520-746-0036.

There will be an **Honor Guard / Color Corps Competition** at 9:00 AM. Every Assembly is urged to field a team and participate.

The Exemplification is scheduled to start at 12:00 Noon. Check the Knights Reservation Desk for correct times. There will be a Ladies Program, Mass, no host social time and a banquet. The Mass will be at 4:00 PM and all priests in attendance are welcome to concelebrate with our celebrant. You are encouraged to attend. One of the top Exemplification Teams in the entire order will present the degree ceremony. All candidates must be in the traditional black tuxedo and pay the fees mandated by Supreme. Active Duty Military, Police and Firefighters are urged to wear their dress uniforms, and Priests their traditional garb. See the Letter of Instruction for more details.

The Class Honoree will be Former Arizona District Master Sir Knight James L. Maino.

Deadline for reservations is March 29th, 2008.

Requirements: To be eligible for the Fourth Degree candidates must have been in the Order for at least one year, attained the Third Degree and be at least eighteen years old. Waivers are available for candidates that do not meet the time requirement but have at least six months as a Knight. Please get waivers in as soon as possible. The waiver requests must have the candidate's membership number and first degree date. Waivers for active duty military scheduled for overseas duty and candidates with life threatening illness will be approved by Supreme with less than the required membership time.

Wives, Friends, and Knights are invited to attend the banquet afterward. The cost of the meal

will be \$40.00 per person with the exception of the candidate's meal, which is paid for by the Master. We will also do a re-enactment of the Knighting Ceremony for those that want to take pictures right after the Degree is completed.

Enclosed is the Exemplification Program for the ceremonial and reservation forms for banquet and ladies luncheon.
